REPORT ON FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, GJBC AND DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY, HATIM 12th & 13th APRIL 2022

The Department of History, Government J. Buana College (GJBC), Lunglei organised a Faculty Exchange Programme with the Department of History, Higher and Technical Institute Mizoram (HATIM), Lunglei on 12th and 13th April 2022.

Four faculty members – two each from both institutions took part in the exchange programme, viz. Dr. Lalzarzoa, Asst. Prof. and Mr. Rothangliana, Asst. Prof. from the Department of History, GJBC, and Mr. Benjamin Lalnunfima, Asst. Prof. & Head of Department and Ms. Lalruathlui Khiangte, Asst. Prof. from the Department of History, HATIM.
