ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

Policy No. 5 of 2022

Ragging Definition:

Ragging is any disorderly conduct by words or action whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm to a junior student creating a sense of shame and embarrassment, adversely affecting the psyche of the junior student or fresher.

Punishment against Ragging:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-ragging and Grievances Redressal Cell of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Cancellation of admission from the college.
- Debarring from appearing in examination.
- Withholding results of internal examination of the college.
- Suspension/expulsion from the college.
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Fine to be paid
- In addition, in case of every single incident of ragging, a First Information Report (FIR) will be filed with the local police authorities. If any students found to be involved in such act shall be punished as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court directions.

Anti-ragging and Grievances Redressal Cell:

Government J.Buana College has a zero tolerance towards any act of ragging. Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the campus. Strict action will be taken against persons flouting this rule; no leniency will be shown.

The Anti-ragging and Grievances Redressal Cell of Gov't J Buana College will be constituted and notified by the College Authority in order to prohibit any kind of ragging within the college premises; and to redress students' grievances on various grounds.

Ragging is a criminal offence and that UGC has framed *UGC Regulations* on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in Indian Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

All students and faculties should be free to lodge their grievances on various issues including Ragging, Academic, Financial and other matters like harassment, discrimination, victimization by teachers, etc.

Complaint procedures:

Confidentiality

The Cell should maintain the confidentiality of all complaints regarding the ragging issue and lodging of Grievances to the extent reasonably possible.

Actions And Redress

The Anti-ragging and Grievances Redressal Cell Committee is empowered to look into matters of harassment. It was suggested that if there are any complaints received by the Cell from the ICT Committee on the issue of any grievances, the Cell will examine, scrutinize, and mete out appropriate measures to redress it by consulting the concerned committee or cell. In case of severe cases, redressing the cases may be forwarded to the Disciplinary Committee, and/or to the Principal if required.

Non- Retaliation

No person against whom a grievance is filed or any other person shall intimidate, threaten, coerce, or discriminate against any individual for filing a grievance or otherwise participating in this process. Complaints of such retaliation or interference may be filed and processed under the supervision of the Principal.

Mandatory Requirements of Anti-Ragging Affidavits:

There are two affidavits - Annexure I to be submitted by the student and Annexure II to be submitted by the parent on plain paper. Verification and attestation of oath commissioner is not required.
