## ABOUT PROF. J. ZOREMA



Prof. J. Zorema is a retired Professor in History with 33 years of teaching experience and 20 years of research experience (excluding years spent in Ph.D.). He had served as the Principal of Govt. J. Buana College in different capacities for four terms. His field of specialization is History of Modern Northeast India. He has numerous publications which include four books as sole author and five books as co-editor, 20 research papers in journals and contributed 14 chapters in edited books. He completed two research projects under ICSSR, New Delhi and UGC (NERO).

He was a member of important organizations/associations including University Court, Mizoram University; Academic Council, Mizoram University; NE India History Association; Mizo History Association; Child Welfare Committee, Lunglei District; Lok Adalat, Lunglei District, Mizoram Youth Commission and several others. He also visited a number of educational institutions as a capacity of NAAC Peer Team.

## THE PROFICIENCY AWARD

The proficiency award, hereinafter called "Prof. J. Zorema Proficiency Award" is the award which will be conferred to the student(s) who excelled in their final (here means sixth semester) examinations. The award will be sponsored by Prof. J. Zorema with a corpus fund of ₹ 50,000. The fund will be recorded as 'Prof. J. Zorema Proficiency Award Corpus Fund' and will be managed by the following committee:

Chairman : The Principal, Govt. J. Buana College

Secretary : The Coordinator, IQAC

Member : The Assistant Coordinator, IQAC Fund Manager: Cashier, Administrative Staff

There will be separate Cash Book to be maintained by the Fund Manager and the Secretary will maintain a complete record which will include - name of awardee(s), division, position and other important academic record.

The fund will be invested in the Fixed Deposit in the name of the Principal, Govt. J. Buana College for a period of one year. However, the fund may be withdrawn under circumstances in

which the committee agreed. After necessary expenditures are met, the balance will be reinvested again for a period of one year.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRTERIA**

The following criteria will be considered for granting 'Prof. J. Zorema Proficiency Award':

- ❖ The student who completes the Programmes during the appropriate year of study will alone be considered for the selection process.
- Students who have cleared all the courses in their first attempt will alone be eligible for the Proficiency Award.
- ❖ Students who secure top-ten positions in the final semester examination conducted by the Mizoram University will be considered for the proficiency award; such students will be awarded as under-
