

PIALTHLENG AND TLAWNG RIVER CLEANING REPORT

A team of 10 dedicated members, comprising students and faculty members from Government J Buana College, participated actively in the "Pialtheng Tihfai Hnatlang" (Pialtheng River Cleaning Drive) on 27 April 2024. Organised by Project Save Tlawng and LDAC, the event took place at Pialtheng, Pukpui. The group focused on cleaning the tributaries that feed the Tlawng River, with Pialtheng being one of its significant tributaries.

The Tlawng River serves as the primary source of public water supply for Lunglei town; however, the river and its tributaries have been plagued by pollution due to litter, polythene, plastics and metal wastes. This cleaning drive is expected to significantly boost the cleanliness of the public water source, ultimately contributing to a healthier environment and community.

The participation of the college team in this initiative demonstrates their commitment to environmental conservation and community service.
